The Cultural Forum organized the following events and activities during the academic year 2024–25:

- **Friendship Day-** The Friendship Day celebration on August 12, 2024, got underway with a lively jam session that excited the youngsters. Interaction between instructors, seniors, and freshmen was the goal of the event. Participants loved snapping pictures at the photo booth and personalised t-shirts with the names of their pals. The spirit of friendship was celebrated with a range of entertaining events.
- **Independence Day** - The college observed Independence Day with a formal gathering on the terrace, followed by a cultural program in the auditorium for the faculty.
- **Teacher's Day-** On September 5, 2024, the Cultural Forum celebrated Teachers' Day with great reverence and fervour. A heartfelt thank you to the committed teachers who have impacted the lives of so many students was expressed throughout the ceremony.
- **Induction Meet** - The Cultural Forum conducted the Induction Ceremony on September 19, 2024, to formally inaugurate the cultural year 2024–2025. The event included the official introduction of departmental heads and the presentation of badges signifying their designated roles and responsibilities. Alongside the ceremony, three cultural events were also held during the same period: Kalakshetram, a poster-making competition, on September 16; Mehfil-e-Mehendi, a mehendi drawing competition, on September 19; and Rangotsav, a rangoli drawing competition, on September 20.
- **Pre- Events** - Spectrum's pre-events were arranged by the Cultural Forum between 2nd December and 5th December 2024. The series started with **Run-Bhoomi**, an exciting cricket competition that drew a large crowd and united the entire college. **Techno-hunt**, an inventive treasure search with thrilling twists brought by the event organisers, came next. The **IPL Auction** tested the competitors' mental fortitude and tested their mathematical and cricket knowledge. Several departments engaged in fierce competition during the eagerly awaited **Departmental Wars. Kick-Off** was the beginning of a journey in which players endeavoured for excellence and established motivating goals. In conclusion, the **Stall Bazaar** offered a distinctive venue for students to display and market their goods on campus, with minimal admission costs and significant earning possibilities.
- **Spectrum-** Spectrum, the prestigious Annual Inter-Collegiate Cultural Festival of Mulund College of Commerce, is organized by the students of the Cultural Forum. This event serves as a vibrant platform to showcase talent, foster creativity, and cultivate the spirit of innovation, encouraging students to engage in a variety of activities beyond their academic pursuits. By doing so, it enriches their college life and provides an avenue for personal growth. This year, Spectrum was held from 18th December to 21st December 2024, and featured an impressive lineup of 24 distinct events spanning performing arts, literary arts, creative arts, athletics, and flagship competitions. The festival saw an enthusiastic participation of 890 students, representing a wide range of colleges, making it an exceptional celebration of creativity and talent.

- **Youth festival** – In the 57th Mumbai University Youth Festival held this year, students from our college actively participated in 24 individual events and 13 group events. Their commendable performances earned a total of 12 prizes in the zonal round and 9 prizes in the final round. These achievements spanned across various categories, including music, dance, theatre, fine arts, and literary arts, reflecting the diverse talents and dedication of our students.
