**FYBCOM (IN-HOUSE) ADMISSION (2026-27)**

**ONLY FOR STUDENTS WHO PASSED HSC EXAM FROM MULUND COLLEGE OF COMMERCE**

Only the students who passed HSC examination from Mulund College of Commerce in the first attempt (February 2026) are eligible to take admission to the FIRST YEAR of Bachelor of Commerce (AIDED) Programme under the in-house quota.

**Please note, the students who filled the HSC Examination form as private students are not eligible for this admission.**

**As the Maharashtra State Board of Education has not released the physical copies of the marksheets, this FYBCOM admission under in-house quota will be considered provisional until the required set of physical documents and forms are submitted with the college. The students would lose the claim on the said admission if they do not get their documents verified and submitted, along with payment of the fee, within the given schedule.**


A schedule for submission of the documents will be announced later. Students are expected to keep a track of notices in this regard.

**Your fee payment is enabled, and it will be active till 11:59 PM, 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2026. Visit the website - [www.feepayr.com](http://www.feepayr.com) and log in through your registered student's mobile number, enter the OTP and pay the fee.**

Once you confirm Your In-house admission by paying the fees, your HSC marksheet and leaving certificate will be retained by the college. The same will be given to you after a year or when you cancel the in-house admission.

The students who do not secure this in-house admission, will not be considered for the FYBCOM admission, when the merit lists get released.

**Common Documents**

- Clear and signed Print out of duly filled **University Registration Form** for First Year of Bachelor of Commerce(Autonomous)- for Mulund College of Commerce (Code- MU-0133)
- Clear and signed Print out of duly filled **College Application Form for FYBCOM Aided** (Application fee Rs. 100/)
- **Class XII Marksheet** (Original & 2 Photocopies)
- **Leaving Certificate of Mulund College of Commerce (1 Photocopy) (2026)**
- **Aadhaar Card** (Original & 1 Photocopy) (Considered as a valid Address Proof)
- **ABC /APAAR ID** (1 Print out)

**Reservation Category Related Documents, As Applicable (1 original & 2 Photocopy)**

- Caste Category Certificate
- Non-Creamy Layer Certificate (For applicable categories- OBC/SBC/NT/VJDT)

Caste Category documents are needed for availing fee benefits. Disability Certificate is needed for receiving the inclusion support and positive affirmation. (Refer to the prospectus and website for updates on scholarship and free-ship notices)

**Note:**

1. The College will retain the class XII marksheet for verification/eligibility status approval. The same will be returned to them by the end of the First Academic Year.
2. The students should take a clear image/scan/PDF of the Class XII marksheet before submitting the same in the office. They would need it for uploading at various portals (including ICAI & ICSI Registration Portals).
3. The students can cancel this admission, if they wish to select other programmes/colleges after the declaration of merit list. The HSC marksheet original will be returned to them and the fee will be refunded after deduction of cancellation charges (refer prospectus for details).
4. Orientation will be held around 15<sup>th</sup> June. Later preferences will be collected for elective subjects and the same will be allocated based on merit and preferences. Details will be communicated in the orientation. The lectures are likely to commence from the third Week of June.
5. Parent/Relative/Friend can complete the admission process on behalf of the student. They need to carry a duly signed authorisation letter, know the user ID & Password and the forms must be signed by the student and the parent. Admissions will be confirmed only when the fee payment is done.
